Fireplace draft properly?

I was at a home that a couple had recently purchased. When they went to use the fireplace (a couple months ago) they got smoke back into the home. When I was there, I noticed that they had a corner fireplace with one and a half sides open. The flue was meant for only a 30" by 30" fireplace opening. Theirs was much bigger. They also took a set of old glass doors off the fireplace, which were there when they bought it. I told them that the glass doors were probably there to reduce the fireplace opening and stop fireplace from spilling smoke.

The homeowner then grumbled about the home inspector for not noticing the flue was not big enough. I mentioned that, honestly, there are certain chimney guys who wouldn't know that this is the problem.

My recommendation for you home inspectors, if you don't have it already, is to make a note regarding your uncertainty regarding how well the fireplace will draft.


